

Clemson University - Application opens on August 1st

The Clemson University application opens on August 1st. **Housing at Clemson is based on when you submit YOUR part of the application (not scores and a transcript).** The priority deadline for Clemson is December 1st. So, if Clemson is on your list, you may want to get your application submitted early in the fall.

Clemson has a single notification date of mid-February. **They do not offer an Early Decision or Early Action option.** Some students who are received institutional scholarships may receive a decision in late fall.

Clemson offers three application options. **We usually recommend that students use the Clemson institutional application, instead of the Common Application or Coalition Application.** The Clemson institutional application is much easier to complete. You will need to create an account to begin the application.

Clemson admits by college, so you will need to select two majors on the application. Do not list the same major twice. Just let us know if you need help selecting the majors. Some majors are more difficult than others (i.e. architecture and nursing).

The Clemson application does not ask for an essay or teacher recommendations. There is a short option at the end of the application for the student to provide a brief personal statement. We usually encourage students to write a short paragraph about their academic interest or journey to date.

The Naviance scattergram for Clemson is attached. This chart indicates admissions decisions for the Class of 2020. Many of the "x" marks on the scattergram were offered a spot in the Bridge program.
