

# Painting Senior Parking Spaces

This is available for all Dalton High School seniors who have a valid parking pass for the 2019-2020 school year. Students will have the opportunity to select and personalize a parking space in the East Parking Lot OR the West Parking Lot that will be theirs throughout the entire school year. This privilege can be taken away if a student loses their parking pass at any time during the school year. Understand however, that **this spot is only yours during the regular school day**. Your spot will be available for anyone to park in after school hours which includes after school activities (sports practices, games, club meetings, banquets or other events) and also for special circumstances (homecoming day, school dances and other events).



## Important Dates and Times

- The form, along with the **\$40 fee**, must be turned in to **Mr. Amonett or the Front Office** at Dalton High School before student will be allowed to paint.
- Spots will be chosen by **first come-first serve**, starting on **August 13** (8am-11am) and on **August 14** (1pm-3pm)
  - Spaces will be reserved pending approval of parking space design, if design is not approved, spot will be given to another student
  - If students return form after August 14 or are unable to come to the school to select their parking spaces, they will select their parking space on **August 24** from spaces available
- Painting days will be **Monday, August 24 9am-4pm and Tuesday, August 25 from 9am-4pm.**
  - There will be an additional paint day on **Saturday, September 5** for students who submit the form but are unable to make the first paint days. Students may still reserve their parking space prior to this paint date
  - Additional days may be worked out between the student and Mr. Amonett
  - Forms will be available after the first day of school for the Saturday paint day
- **IF FORM IS NOT TURNED IN BEFORE PAINT DAY**, student may lose reserved parking space
- **ONLY** you or a parent/guardian may bring this form to Dalton High School

## Form Information

- You **MUST** complete the attached form/drawing to be able to paint your spot
- Cost is **\$40 to paint a spot** in addition to the \$30 price for a parking pass (\$70 total). This money **MUST** be turned in with the form.
- The form requires:
  - A sketch of the parking spot design
  - A parent signature

## Design Information

- A sketch of your design must be drawn in the space provided on the attached form.
  - These designs will be reviewed by the school to ensure appropriate content
  - Design must follow the code of conduct
- Your **first and last name will be required to be painted** somewhere in your space
  - Make sure it is legible
- **NO** other names can be written in your space.
- Chalk and brooms will be available on the painting days for you to use before painting your parking spot

## Paint Information

- Students **must bring their own paint and their own brushes!** The school will NOT provide any supplies.
- **NO** spray paint will be allowed
- Home Depot and Lowes are great places to buy your paint.


