

# 5th Grade Donation List

All fifth grade students will need the following supplies which may be donated or will be provided for those who are unable to bring them from home.

wireless mouse	optional, but <b>HIGHLY</b> recommended- <i>students who have a wireless mouse find it MUCH easier to use their laptop</i> (around \$15) NO BLUETOOTH PLEASE! This will also need additional batteries throughout the year.
ear buds or SMALL headphones	<i>This is a CRITICAL supply that will be used every day. Please choose a pair with a mic (often the right ear piece of earbuds is a mic) and volume control.</i> These <b>MUST</b> stay at school all year. NO BLUETOOTH PLEASE! Headphones that connect via USB work best, but are more expensive.
1 inch binder—regular binder, nothing fancy or huge, or padded	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• hard cover</li> <li>• front and back inside pockets</li> <li>• <b>NO huge, padded or zippered binders please</b></li> </ul>
1 spiral notebook	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 70 sheets (no thick notebooks)</li> <li>• wide ruled, standard page size</li> </ul>
3 two-pocket folders	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 1 red, 1 blue, 1 yellow</li> <li>• <b>NOT plastic, NO metal prongs</b></li> <li>• usually go on sale for about 10-20 cents each</li> </ul>
1 fabric zippered pencil pouch for a three ring binder	
5 pencils and 1 pen	<i>Mechanical pencils are recommended to avoid touching the pencil sharpener, but send a supply of lead as well.</i>
Colored pencils	<i>1 pack of 12 is perfect!</i>
crayons	<i>1 pack of 24</i>
Plastic crayon container	<i>Need 2-one for earbuds, one for crayons</i>
Elmer's school glue (white liquid glue)	<i>1 bottle (4oz.)</i>
Scissors	<i>Need to fit in the zippered pouch</i>
Small hand sanitizer	<i>1 individual bottle w/ carabiner or hook (to hook to the student's tote bag)</i>

**Strongly recommended: Reusable water bottle with "pop top" closure**
