Operating Model: Fluid Hybrid

In Person: “A/B In School”

- All Students on Campus Everyday (Who Want to Be)
- Restricted Classroom Capacity with Overflow Spaces (Cafeteria, Auditorium)
- Remote Learning in Overflow
- Only Few Students in Overflow

Remote Learning

- All Classes Broadcast Using Interactive OWL Camera Setup
- Immersive: Students at Home Can See Speakers & Be Heard By Whole Class
- Online Attendance Equivalent to In Person Attendance
- Opt-In Any Time

- Custom Fabricated Acrylic Barriers for Students & Faculty
- Face Shields & Gloves for Faculty
- Plexiglass Dividers in Public Facing Spaces (Offices, Library)
- Nursing Office & Infirmary Fully Equipped and Stocked

Physical Distancing

- Desks Spaced 3-6 Feet Apart in Classroom
- Reduced Class Size: 16% Classes Have More Than 20 Students
- Removed 205, 209, NH002 (Using Library & Campus Min)
- Renting Two 25 x 30 Heated Tents to Create Outdoor Classroom Space
- One-Way Hallways, No/Restricted Locker Access
- 15 Minutes Passing
- Reducing Number of Class Changes in Day

Classrooms Sanitized with Electrostatic Process 2x Week

All Classrooms Equipped with Wipes, Sanitizer, Students
Can Clean Desks and Common Surfaces Between Periods

Lunch: Break During Day

Pre-Order Meals Using Online System (Hot & Cold Options)

Delivered Packaged to Set Locations

Combination of Spaces to Spread Students Out Including Outside

Partnership: Affirmative Obligation Stay Home

Revise Family ID Absence Forms: "Zooming Today"

Minimize "Paper" Requirements

Backpacks, Warm Weather Uniform
