- Listen and respond respectfully to all staff

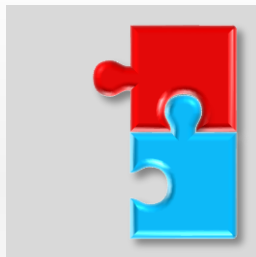
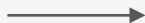
## Online
