## **Device User Agreement - Farmington Junior High School**

Each student at Farmington Junior High School will be issued a laptop and charging cord. These items will be checked out to students the first week of school, through their Personal Learning Time (PLT) advisory class, and checked in at the end of the school year. Laptops and other items will only be issued to enrolled Farmington Junior High School students. Students from other schools taking classes at Farmington Junior High School will be responsible for providing their own devices.

This form ensures that equipment supplied by Farmington Junior High will be used and maintained in its original condition by the designated student named below. Reasonable wear and tear expected. By signing this form, students will demonstrate reasonable care with the respect to the security and physical well-being of the equipment signed to his/her care. In the absence of reasonable care or if the equipment is returned in a condition different than the original condition, students will be financially responsible. In addition, in the event that Farmington Junior High School determines in its sole discretion that the student did not utilize reasonable care in the use of the equipment, the student will be responsible for any damaged, lost, or stolen equipment. All specified equipment is and shall at all times remain the property of the District and must be returned by the last day of the school year or the student's last day of enrollment in the school, whichever comes first.

By signing this agreement, both the Student and Parent agree:

- To abide by the Davis School District Acceptable Use Policy
- To use the equipment primarily for educational use.
- To not install or remove any software without prior authorization from the District.
- To not install virtual private networks (VPN) or other software that circumvents district filters on district provided devices.
- To report any problems, damages, misuse, or misconduct immediately to the advisor or administrator. All repairs must be completed by district approved vendors.
- That the equipment is the property of the District and must be returned prior to the student's last day of attendance of the current school year.
- That if the equipment is not returned to the District in its original condition, reasonable wear and tear excepted, or if the equipment is damaged, lost, or stolen, due to the student's negligence or not utilizing reasonable care in the use of the equipment, reasonable wear and tear excepted as determined exclusively by the District, student agrees to be financially responsible for the replacement value of the equipment as determined by the District.
- That all information stored on equipment carries no expectation of privacy and is property of the District. Any information or use of the equipment carries no expectation of privacy.
- The District reserves the right, at all times and without prior notice, to inspect and search any and all its property for the purpose of determining whether any policy has been violated, or when an inspection and investigation is necessary for purposes of promoting safety or compliance with state and federal laws.

Parent/Guardians may choose among the following options for ensuring their student has a device for accessing the curriculum, resources, and assessments:

- Parent/Guardian can allow the student to check out a school-provided device and enroll in the Discretionary
  Insurance for Device Protection Plan which requires a \$25 non-refundable fee. A \$15 fee will be assessed per
  incident. Discretionary Insurance for Device Protection Plan may not be purchased after damage has occurred, or
  beyond the first term of the school year. This can be paid under "optional fees" in myDSD.
- Parent/Guardian can allow the student to check out a district-provided device and <u>not</u> enroll in the <u>Discretionary</u> <u>Insurance for Device Protection Plan</u>. Parent/Guardian will assume full financial responsibility for the school-issued mobile device.

# Farmington Junior High School - Discretionary Device Protection Plan

Farmington Junior High School is providing a protection plan for students and parents as part of our User Device Agreement. Enrollment in the plan is optional with the understanding that if students/parents do not enroll in the protection plan they may carry full liability for the laptop in the same way they do for other damaged or lost school property, such as textbooks.

## **Program Fees and Coverage**

- Fee: \$25 per school year. This fee is nonrefundable and will not be prorated.
- Maximum Expense: \$225, 2020-2021 replacement cost of Cloudbook
- Coverage: Repair or replacement of school issued laptop

## **Enrollment Deadline**

Plan may not be purchased after damage has occurred, or beyond 30 days after the laptop is issued to the student.

# **Effective Coverage / Expiration Date**

- Effective Date: Coverage begins when the \$25 nonrefundable fee is paid.
- Expiration Date: Coverage ends on the earliest of the following dates: last day of school year, return of device, no longer enrolled in school.

Please be sure to return the device before the expiration date to ensure that the plan is always in effect.

### Coverage

### The Optional Device Protection Plan coverage includes:

- Accidental damage caused by liquid, spills, drops, or other unintentional events.
- Loss of device due to theft; claim must be accompanied by a valid police report.
- Damage caused by fire; claim must be accompanied by official fire report from investigating authority.
- Damage due to an electrical surge.
- Loss or damage caused by natural disasters.

#### **Exclusions**

### The Optional Device Protection Plan coverage excludes:

- Damage caused by dishonest, fraudulent, intentional, and negligent (not locked and/or stored in an insecure manner or location) or criminal acts. Students and parents will be responsible for the full amount of repair/replacement for damage or loss that falls in this category.
- Damage incurred to a device that is not kept in a protective case (students may purchase for \$4.00 from the school or provide their own).
- AC adapters and charging cord.
- "Jailbreaking" or otherwise voiding the manufacturer's warranty by altering the software. Jailbreaking is a term used to describe a process by which normal manufacturer controls on the functionality of the device are bypassed. Jailbreaking of school-issued laptop devices is not permitted.
- Farmington Junior High School is not liable for any loss, damage (including incidental, consequential, or punitive damages), or expense caused directly or indirectly by the equipment.

# **Replacement Costs**

#### **Protection Plan:**

- A \$15 fee will be assessed per covered incident
- Subsequent Claim during school year
  - Full device repair cost or replacement cost (if device is recovered, device must be returned to school and replacement fee will be reimbursed)

#### No Protection Plan:

> All incidents- Full device repair or replacement cost.
