



FAQ for Covid-19 International Travel

What documents should I carry with me to travel?

- Current Passport
- Valid F-1 Visa
- I-20 Document
- VES Enrollment Verification Letter (provided by the school)
- VES Emergency Contact Information (provided by the school)
- CBP's Carrier Liaison Program Information Sheet for students from the Schengen area, Ireland and the UK (provided by the school)
- A printed copy of I-94 Last Port of Entry for Returning Students:

- **REQUIRED:** Medical certificate with a negative Coronavirus (COVID-19) PCR test result issued at most 96 hours before departure

What can I expect when I arrive at Dulles Airport?

- Face covering will be required
- Excerpt from Department of Homeland Security: *Upon arrival, travelers will proceed to standard customs processing. They will then continue to enhanced entry screening where the passenger will be asked about their **medical history, current condition**, and asked for **contact information for local health authorities**. Passengers will then be given written guidance about COVID-19 and directed to proceed to their final destination, and immediately home quarantine in accordance with CDC best practices. To ensure compliance, local and state public health officials will contact individuals in the days and weeks following their arrival.*
