AT-HOME LEARNERS NORMS AND EXPECTATIONS

- Students learning at home should establish and maintain a structure for their day, beginning with a regular bedtime and wake-up time each day. They should expect to attend school during regular school day hours if residing in the United States. Students learning at home are expected to join classes synchronously except in the case of time zone challenges.
- Students learning outside the United States will be expected to keep up with in class work and attend weekly office hours for each class and advisory. Students are encouraged and expected to attend class and advisory synchronously whenever practicable.
- Students must attend class from an established, prepared, well-lit work space, and must have ready access to all books or class materials and technological resources.
- Students must dress in the spirit of the dress code (collared shirts, no t-shirts or sweatshirts with writing, etc.) if not in dress code in fact.
- Students learning at home are full members of our community and as such, we encourage all students learning at home to participate in the life of the school and to stay as connected with friends, classmates, and teachers as they are able.
