

Supply List for Eighth Grade 2020-2021

General PPE (personal protective equipment):

- Families will be asked to provide **five masks for their student – one for each day of the week**. Find masks that are comfortable and fit well. Please have your student practice wearing them. Children will be more likely to want to wear a mask that they like, so consider finding one with a fun pattern or character. Review proper mask etiquette (keep mask over nose, avoid adjusting mask, etc.) The school has a supply of disposable face masks, should your child ever need a replacement mask.
- Optional - personal small bottle of hand sanitizer. The school has dispensers throughout the campus. Please write your name on the bottle in permanent marker
- Optional, but permitted - face shields
- Optional, but permitted - latex-free gloves

In general, during reduced-density learning model:

- A small, washable blanket, towel, or mat that can be used for outdoor lunch, recess, or other outdoor seated activities. (These opportunities may not be daily, but we will try to be outside often.)
- Facial tissues (pocket-sized or a small box)

In general:

- **Please note that we will not be using lockers while in our reduced-density model.**
- Backpack
- Chromebook-compatible headphones
- Pencil Box or bag for writing utensils listed above
- The school will provide each student a bin that will help house supplies in their main classroom, in addition to existing desk storage.
- highlighters in 3 bright colors (Chinese requires yellow and pink)
- loose leaf paper
- dividers for binders
- graph paper (1/4 inch works well)
- index cards
- Pencil Box or bag for all writing utensils listed across classes
- pens (black/blue only)
- pencils with erasers
- extra eraser(s)
- transparent ruler marked in centimeters
- 3 hole punch
- Pencil sharpener (if not using mechanical pencils)
- reinforcements for broken holes in loose leaf
- colored pencils

Although some teachers are not asking for binders, some students do well with one of the following, which helps them keep everything organized:

One large binder (with a zipper) for all subjects

OR

An expanding, accordion-style pocket folder with sections for each subject
