Congratulations, we would like to welcome to our Committed Distance Learning program within Olentangy Schools! I'm Jennifer Furey, and I will serve as your Lead Administrator. Please consider this email as verification that your child has been accepted from the wait list and has a spot in this temporary online school program.

I am excited for your child to participate in the Committed Distance Learning program and welcome the opportunity to lead a program in which your child will continue their educational journey with the district. This is a new experience for all of us, and our goal is to deliver an authentic Olentangy learning experience, coupled with innovative virtual opportunities.

I am certain you have many questions as to what this program will look like. First, I want to emphasize that Olentangy's foundations of curriculum, assessment and instruction will be prevalent in this online education format. Schoology will be our digital learning platform for receiving lessons, assignments and live interaction. I will send updates to our Committed Distance Learning community on Mondays and Thursdays, with teachers facilitating the daily learning and delivering instruction. As parents, it will be important for you to ensure your child logs in for lessons at their appointed times, completes assignments, and communicates with their teacher regarding coursework.

- PowerSchool will open on August 24th, with student's teacher assignments and class schedules.

- Gifted students and IEP students will continue to receive services in the Committed Distance Learning model.
- Food service is available to students. We will share how to pre-order and pick up meals next week

In order to ensure families without access to technology receive the necessary tools, district devices will be distributed based on need.
