Instructions to Access Schedule and Cohort Information for Returning Students

Schedules and **cohort assignments** are available to be viewed online for returning students via the Parent Connect Portal. Once logged in, you will see a dropdown menu located under "**Reports**" at the top of the screen. In the dropdown menu, select "**Schedule**" (**not** "Next Year Schedule" as we have moved into the new school year). The last step requires you to then **click on the printer icon**. This will open a new window that shows your 2020-21 schedule along with your cohort assignment. Please make sure your pop-up blocker has been disabled.
