

The PATRIOT TRAFFIC PLAN:

Please drop off all of your kids at the YOUNGEST child's designated area. Then your older child/children can go to their assigned area.

MORNING DROP OFF by 7:40 daily, but no earlier than 7:15.

Morning Schedule

Remember: Students should not arrive earlier than 7:15am

K, 1st, and 2nd – Lindenwood drive/circle back by K/2 building. Please line up on Lindenwood Street 3rd, 4th and 5th – on Forest Trail by the bike racks. Please line up on Forest Trail; **exit Chatterton.**

When arriving at school students will go to their designated waiting areas. These areas are:

- **K-1 Wing hallway Socially distanced 6ft apart**
- **2-3 Will be located in the gym in designated spots 6ft apart**
- **4-5 Will be located in the cafeteria in designated spots 6ft apart**
- **7:30 teachers will go to designated areas to gather students and begin instructional day.**
- **7:40am First Bell** – students should be in class for breakfast
- **7:45am Tardy Bell** – all students should be **in class ready to begin their day** of learning. Please see the SAISD Student Handbook concerning compulsory attendance and missing any part of a day. **Students who arrive after 7:40 should go directly to class.** Teachers will enter tardies in the computer starting at 7:45. All teachers begin the day with a bell ringer activity that reviews material from previous lessons. Please understand, however, during the first week, we will be flexible as we outline our policies

AFTERNOON PICK UP AT 3:00 – parents will stay in their vehicles for the safety of our kids. Also, please be courteous and take turns as cars need to cross intersections.

K, and 1st –

- Lindenwood drive/circle back by K/2 building. Line up on Lindenwood.
- Teachers will watch for your **car tag**, so please have your visor down so they can see it. Students will be dismissed from their classrooms to ensure social distancing. Once students are dismissed, they will wait at designated cones 6ft apart to ensure proper social distancing.
- Please turn right out of Lindenwood and exit to Sunset.

2nd -5th

- **2nd grade will dismiss in the front with 3rd – 5th.**

- **2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th** – On Forest Trail at bike racks. Line up on Forest Trail; **exit Chatterton**. 2nd grade students will release through the side gate to their designated waiting area. They will line up in front of their designated flag and socially distanced 6ft apart. The social distancing markers will be designated using flags.
- 3rd will release through the front doors. They will line up in front of their designated flag and socially distanced 6ft apart. The social distancing markers will be designated using flags.
- 4th grade will release through the cafeteria. Using staggered dismissal times. They will line up in front of their designated flag and socially distanced 6ft apart. The social distancing markers will be designated using flags. (Students 10 & up will be asked to wear masks.)
- 5th grade will release through their classrooms. Using staggered dismissal. They will line up in front of their designated flag and socially distanced 6ft apart. The social distancing markers will be designated using flags. (Students 10 & up will be asked to wear masks.)
- Parents will pull as far forward as possible; students will be released to walk to you.

Remember, please exit left on Chatterton to help with K – 3 traffic exiting beyond that point.

Again, our plan is asking all parents to stay in your car at drop off and pick up. The morning lines go quickly. In the afternoons, we need everyone to be patient, especially as we learn cars. After the first few days, our goal is to clear the campus by 3:05. We hope you do not mind taking 10 minutes to pick up your child/children. If you come at 3:00, lines move quickly. We will have car tags for all K – 2 students. Please put them on your right visor and lower it as you enter the pickup line

The front circle will be accessed by daycare vans and buses only. They must have easy access in and out to keep their schedules for other campuses.

It may take a few days to get the procedures down, but we hope this plan helps everyone, especially our kids who we all want to be safe. THANK YOU for your support!
