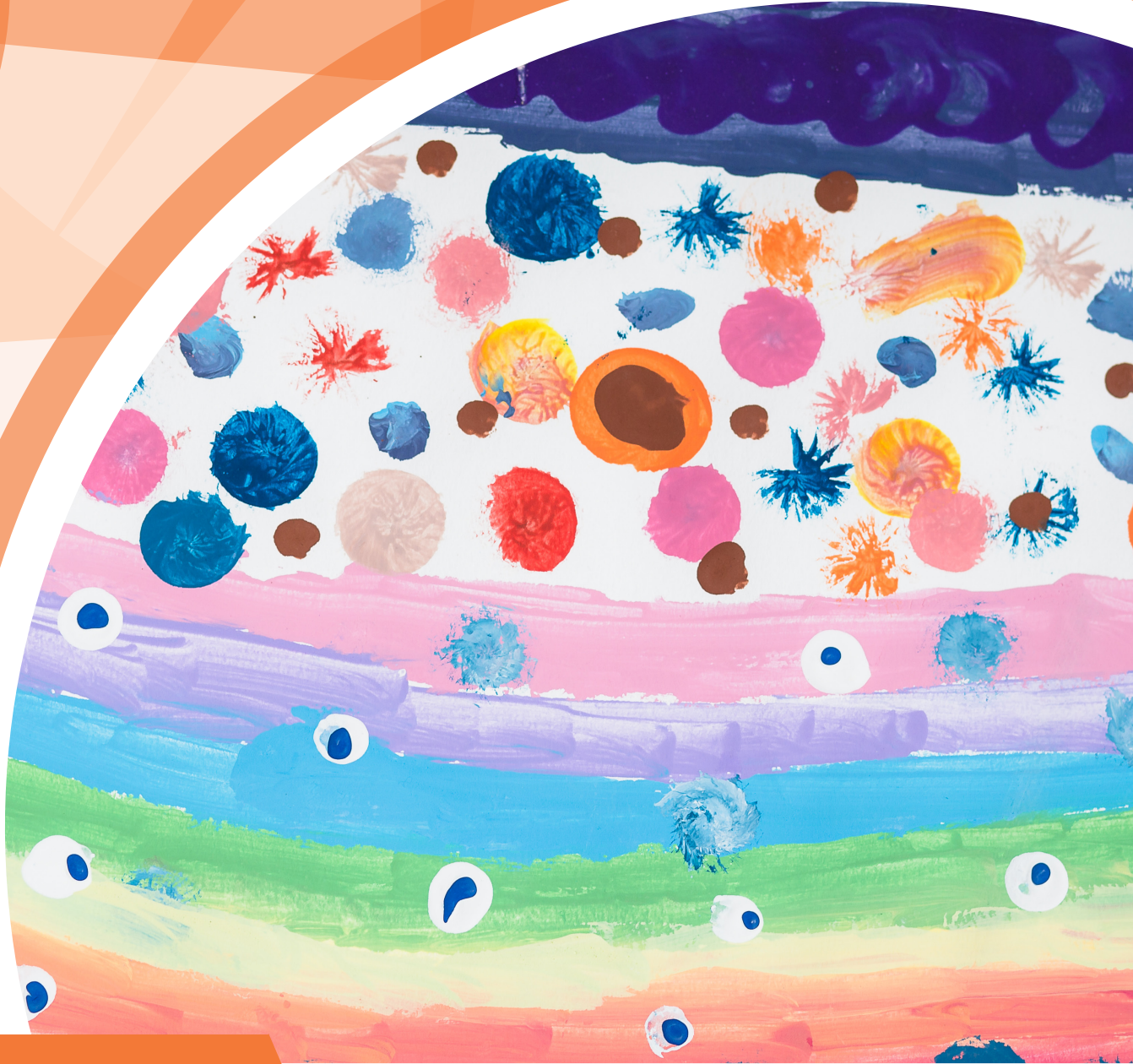


DID YOU KNOW?

DID YOU KNOW?

For the past eight years, Sun Prairie fourth graders have participated in Kindness Retreats. These day-long events help to build a more caring community by engaging students in activities that demonstrate the value of kindness and the effects of bullying. During the retreats, Sun Prairie High School and Prairie Phoenix Academy students and adult mentors act as positive role models and assist the fourth graders by facilitating conversations including:

- understanding why and how to make kind choices
- enhancing empathy skills to understand how words and actions help others
- acquiring conflict resolution skills to safely deal with bullying

The retreats are presented by Youth Frontiers, Inc., a Minneapolis-based non-profit organization, and are funded by community organizations including the Rotary Club, Sun Prairie Education Foundation, Bank of Sun Prairie, School SCO groups, and more.
