2020-098: RESOLUTION IMPLEMENTING REDUCTION IN FORCE IN ADMINISTRATIVE STAFF AND TRANSFER OF ADMINISTRATOR TO A TEACHING POSITION

A motion was made by Mr. Shroyer and seconded by Dr. Roer, to consider approving the following resolution:

WHEREAS, after consideration of all alternatives and despite the resignation and retirement of administrators employed by the Board during the prior school year, the Board determines it necessary to reduce the number of its administrator positions due to financial conditions affecting the District; and

WHEREAS, after giving consideration to administrators who have greater seniority in administrative service with the District and who are properly licensed and certified for particular positions, all in the best interests of the District and in accordance with Board Policy 1540 and Ohio Revised Code Section 3319.171, the Superintendent recommends that the contract of the Assistant Athletic Director, Duane Pullins, be suspended, effective close of business August 13, 2020; and

WHEREAS, Board Policy requires that Duane Pullins be offered a position as a classroom teacher in his licensure and certification area because he was previously employed by the Board under a continuing teaching contract and has more seniority of service as a licensed and certified K-12 Spanish classroom teacher than other K-12 Spanish teachers employed by the Board and the Superintendent recommends him for employment under a continuing contract in that teacher position with all of his District system seniority intact, effective August 14, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Centerville City School District that, after consideration of all alternatives and despite the resignation and retirement of administrators employed by the Board during the prior school year, the Board determines it necessary to reduce the number of its administrator positions due to financial conditions affecting the District; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in accordance with the recommendation of the Superintendent, after giving consideration to administrators who have greater seniority in administrative service with the District and who are properly licensed and certified for particular positions, all in the best interests of the District and in accordance with Board Policy 1540 and Ohio Revised Code Section 3319.171, the administrative employment contract of the Assistant Athletic Director, Duane Pullins, be suspended, effective close of business August 13, 2020; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Duane Pullins be employed on a continuing contract as a K-12 Spanish Teacher subject to assignment by the Superintendent with all of his District system seniority intact, effective August 14, 2020; and

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Treasurer is authorized and directed to provide Duane Pullins written notice of the suspension of his administrator contract and employment as a continuing contract teacher subject to assignment by the Superintendent along with a copy of this Resolution by certified U.S. Mail and electronic mail.
