SAFETY PROCEDURES FOR PICK-UP:

Enter the front parking lot. Students must wear masks. Students will enter the west door (closest to train tracks) of the cafetorium. We will have student volunteers to direct the students for their safety. Once in the cafetorium the students will be directed to the photographers who will take their picture and provide them with their ID. They will be given their packet of information and will exit the building through the front doors of the high school. Students will social distance in and outside of the building. Only 10 individuals will be allowed within the cafeteria at any time. Students will be instructed to wait outside the building, 6-feet apart, until given access to the cafeteria.
