Individualized Plan for Care

The CT Office of Early Childhood requires that all children with a special health need have an individualized plan for care on file. This form or a form provided by the child's pediatrician must be completed and signed by the pediatrician and by the parent/guardian. The plan must be a step-by-step strategy that the CARE teachers can put in place in case of emergency or need for intervention. All children that have an allergy, special dietary need, dental issue, hearing or visual impairment, chronic illness, developmental delay, or a history of contagious disease qualify for a required individualized care plan. This form will be in your child's file, and a copy will be placed in the classroom for CARE staff reference.
