

## BBJH Reopening of School 2020-2021 School Year

### School:

- Start date of this school year for students is September 8, 2020.
- Schedule will be a hybrid schedule of A and B days:
  - A days - Monday and Thursday,
  - B days - Tuesday and Friday.
  - Students do not attend school on Wednesday.
- We will begin school on the A and B hybrid schedule beginning with group B students on Tuesday, September 8, 2020. There is no staggered start.
- Days students attend school in the hybrid schedule are referred to as face to face days.
- Days students remain working from home in the hybrid schedule are referred to as distance learning days.
- Letters will be mailed home and a JCALL will go out on August 24th to parents about the start dates. Parents with access to the parent portal can access this information on the portal beginning on August 24th.

### Uniforms:

#### BBJH SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

- SHIRTS-Red or white polo, short or long sleeve
- PANTS- Navy pants **\*NO SHORTS \*NO JEAN MATERIAL\* NO JOGGERS\***
  - Navy skirts **\*NO JEAN MATERIAL \*2 INCHES ABOVE THE KNEE\***
- BELTS ARE MANDATORY
- SOCKS ARE MANDATORY **\*PLAIN NAVY OR WHITE TIGHTS/KNEE HIGH SOCKS (NO GRAPHICS)\***
- SHOES- No sandals, boots, moccasins, crocs, slippers or heels above one inch. **\*CLOSED TOE SHOES ONLY\***
- SWEATSHIRTS/SWEATERS- **\*NO HOODS\*** Solid black, navy, white, red, gray, or maroon **ONLY**
- COATS/JACKETS- **\*NO HOODS\*** Solid black, navy, gray, white, or maroon **ONLY**
- UNDERSHIRTS- Solid navy, red, or white **ONLY**
- **ALL STUDENTS MUST WEAR A MASK DAILY. \*NO POLITICAL, RELIGIOUS, MOVEMENT, OR PROFANITY ON THE MASK\***
- BBJH will be selling sweatshirts and spirit shirts. Order forms will be sent home at a later date.
- Backpacks and other bags (sports equipment, etc) must be either mesh or see through.

### **School Material/Equipment:**

- School fees and supply list remain the same and are located on the school's website. We will not be collecting for PE uniforms at this time as we will not be dressing out for PE.
- All students of BBJH (face to face and virtual) will be assigned a chromebook. This chromebook must be checked out by appointment through the school (this includes virtual students). We will notify you when we are scheduling appointments. Insurance is available to purchase for the chromebook rental. Insurance must be paid for with cash or money money order.
- Student chromebooks will have a charger. It is the child's responsibility to charge the chromebook nightly.
- All students are allowed to bring a water bottle with water. The bottle must be clear and contain water only. Our water fountains will be closed.

### **Daily Procedures:**

- School begins at 7:50 am and ends at 3:15 pm for all students.
- Breakfast and lunch will be served daily. Classes will report to the cafeteria at designated times to wash hands and pick up food.
- All students will follow their assigned schedule throughout the hybrid schedule.
- Transition times between classes have been increased to allow for proper sanitation to the rooms.
- Sanitation stations will be set up around the school for students.
- Social distance markers will be placed around the school to adhere to guidelines.
- School will have one flow of traffic for all staff and students to follow.
- Students who are on their distance learning day will need to log in from home by 7:50 am. Attendance will be taken daily through google classroom.
- Buses will be running but may be making more than one load so the pick up and drop off time for your child may be adjusted from last year. Bus drivers should be trying to contact parents concerning their times.

Your patience and understanding throughout these unprecedented times is greatly appreciated. Hopefully, this is the last time an update in regards to the start of school will be required.
