Synchronous Learning

Students and teachers working together, simultaneously on the same lesson/ assignment. This includes all forms of direct instruction or activity such as Zoom, Kahoots, Padlet, etc.

Asynchronous Learning

Students working independently or in small groups outside of the full class setting. This can include break out sessions, Padlet, EdPuzzle, pre-taped or assigned video lessons, read at home, independent assignments.

Attendance

Students need to sign in daily during their assigned class time. They need to have their camera and audio on for attendance. Attendance should be tracked each session to verify participation for the period. Students screen names need to be their full legal name for attendance purposes. Students not signed in and participating during class time may lose or receive a lowered participation grade for that day. (For the first 10 days, please email your 2nd period headcount to Yaneli Cruz)

Student Email Accounts

Students have Outlook 365 email accounts. Their Username is their school email. Their new passwords were sent home in a letter from the District Office. If they have not yet received their password, they can call into the front office or contact their counselor. You may also view their Default Password under their profile. If you click on the Supplemental tab, it will be towards the bottom of the page under the heading: Default Password.

- Make sure they are using Outlook for email. Students do not have Gmail accounts. They log into Google only to access their Google Classroom and Google Suite Apps.
