



## Title I Parent & Family Engagement Policy 2020-2021

**This plan has been written to outline and promote communication and cooperation between parents/families and Faith Elementary.**

1. Faith is a schoolwide Title I school; therefore, all students at Faith are considered Title I students.
2. Due to the current COVID-19 pandemic, and social distancing guidelines issued by the state, our beginning of year Title I parent meeting will be held *virtually*. The meeting will be held on **Thursday, August 20th, 2020.**
3. Our School-Home Agreement should be signed by each student, parent, classroom teacher, and principal and referenced throughout the school year. Due to the current pandemic, and social distancing guidelines, the school-home agreements will be signed and submitted electronically this year.
4. Folders with student work will be sent home weekly for all students and shared digitally on ClassDojo/SeeSaw/Canvas. These folders and online programs will contain work samples of individual students.
5. Parents and guardians will be given an opportunity to attend virtual (in person if permitted) Title I sponsored workshops throughout the year to promote the education of their child. Events will be planned at flexible times during the day and parents are encouraged to attend as often as possible.
6. A goal of 80% parent participation in at least one parent activity (virtual/in-person) has been established for the 2020-2021 school year.
7. Parents/Guardians may request professional qualifications of their child's teacher(s) or paraprofessional(s) and will be asked to participate in various surveys throughout the year.
8. Parents/Guardians will be notified when their child is being served by an individual that does not meet North Carolina's state licensure requirements for four or more consecutive weeks.
