ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS LESSONS

- ELA should be chunked into mini lessons
- They may be doing 3 to 4 smaller lessons/practice sessions that are 10-15 minutes long
- Students are not expected to do all the mini lessons at once

MATH LESSONS

- Depending on the skill, it might need to be chunked into smaller lessons/practice sessions much like ELA

SCIENCE AND SOCIAL STUDIES LESSONS

- Alternating days with lessons approximately 15 minutes in length

SPECIALS

- Students will be provided a daily lesson via the specials rotation (Art, Music, PE, Library, etc) of approximately 15 minutes in length.
- Students might have access to more lessons if they would like to complete more.
- PE teachers will share an activity log with students to track the required 120 minutes of physical activity per week.

ADDITIONAL LESSONS

- Read or be read to for 20 minutes each day
- 1st and 2nd grade students will work in Reflex Math every day
- Students will have the opportunity to participate in 15-20 minute live lessons via Google meet each day. This may be a small group activity or individual.
- Additional services are provided for students who qualify for English Language Learner, Special Education/504, or PEAK services.
- All first time instruction that is live streamed will be recorded so all students have access through SeeSaw.
