EVERY WEEKDAY WITH CORE AND ELECTIVE CLASSES

- Each teacher will post instructional content, practice work, multi-day projects or discussion boards for students to complete daily.
- Every class period will have new or continuing assignments daily.
- A student is considered present when evidence demonstrates student progress towards learning objectives and demonstrates regular student engagement in class/course activities.

Students are expected to check Google Classroom daily in every subject area.

Teachers will be available daily for assistance with assignments and clarification of instruction through Google Classroom. Teachers will maintain their regular classroom schedule and be available through Google Classroom, email, or scheduled phone calls.

In order to meet all student learning needs, all group instruction that is live-streamed will be recorded and posted in Google Classroom to be available for all students.

TIME FRAME

Time spent on each class will vary. High school students will be enrolled in 7 classes. Middle school students will be enrolled in 6 classes. Students are expected to be engaged in their coursework every day.

EVERY WEEK

Students may check on their progress - missing assignments, comment on work, questions/concerns through PowerSchool Student Portal.
