- 2. Vanessa (2-55 minutes)
  - a. Pandemic School Procedures They are sincerely taking all of these guidelines seriously. They are implementing safety procedures in the building, with lunch, etc.
    - they'll be asked to wear a mask as soon as they enter school grounds
    - Come stand on the stars for their class out on the playground
    - When the school day begins: staggering teachers teachers will be responsible to keep procedures and stay distanced
    - Temperatures will NOT be taken as students enter school. Temperatures will be taken on a case by case basis if a situation arises
    - Stations in each classroom with sanitizers, cubbies one for each student
    - Each cubby has a tote with each student's belongings
    - No floor/carpet time kids will have to stay in their seats
    - Everyone is responsible for doing their very best
    - Teachers have been in measuring desks to be 6ft apart room in the classrooms for about 14 desks
    - There were will be opportunities for teachers to teach without a mask
    - Parents are asking: can we wear our own mask from home? Yes. Can we use a bandana or shield? No. Masks are expected per the governor. Teachers will be teaching kids mask usage.
       There will be times when masks will not be needed. Kids will be taken care of with masks.
    - Per the district you can have two ten minute recesses or one twenty minute; our school has
      decided to one 20 minute recess a day, opposite of their prep time. Any time they leave the
      classroom and come back, students will be responsible to sanitize.
    - Teachers are not allowed to bring their own sanitizing products. Everything has to be district approved.
    - PARENT REQUEST: Paper sacks for lunches instead of lunch boxes
    - Lunch: they have a lunch room supervisor plus a sanitizing supervisor. Kids aren't allowed to touch anything. Sort of grab and go, but evolved where they can choose and pick it up.
    - Days that kids are home from school are allowed to come to the school at designated time and get lunch, but it will need to be paid for, unless the student qualifies for free/reduced lunch.
    - If a student falls ill, a teacher will send them to the office and parents will be called. If parents report back a positive test, they have to work with the health dept. They will only be alerted if a

- student was in close proximity of that student and has a high risk situation. Because of privacy, people will positive tests will not be identified by the school. 15 cases in a school could put the school in quarantine.
- End of the day: kids are expected to sanitize before they leave the school. All teachers will be outside to help manage kids and keep them from gathering in groups. Starting 3:15-3:20, classes will stagger exiting the building.
- Buses will be the same they will run the same time as usual but should have fewer kids. Schools will be responsible to manage their own buses as much as possible.
- Pick up procedures should stay the same
- b. A/B Schedule Daily Learning not like last spring!
  - People from the district have been working overtime on class curriculum for online learning. CANVAS will be huge! All students in the same grade will be paced the same.
  - What will happen with my kids on remote days? They will be instructed in Canvas in class, and then will have a lesson in canvas to work on in home, and the next in person learning day they will follow up. Everyday there will be new content except Fridays. Fridays = Regular work day for educators, but will be a review day. One-on-one meetings, small group meetings, zoom meetings, etc. Also for specific interventions on topics that are being missed. Everyone is a little bit behind, so Fridays will also be used for catching people up. FRIDAY ISN'T A PLAY DAY!
  - Kids should have about 2 ½ hours a day of work on remote learning days. Example: 8-10 minute video of instruction and then a practice piece after. IT'S GOING TO WORK!
  - Digital learning can be accessed any time, so there is flexibility of when your student does their work. It does need to be completed at some point during that day.
  - If parents struggle with something on a digital day, message the teacher. Don't make things painful or stress unsupported. Teachers will not necessarily get back to you, but will look at it with your student on the next in-person day.
  - There will be job openings for aids coming out anyone could apply. A lot of little jobs will be available. Also looking for covid assistants, etc.
  - VOLUNTEERS! The district suggestion is to limit volunteers. Classroom parties will look different. It will be on a class by class basis and will be minimal.
  - No whole school assemblies, but there will be grade level assemblies with kids staying 6 feet apart.
  - Frist week of school: Group B will come Tuesday and Thursday, and Group A will come Wednesday and Friday.
  - BIG 5 GUIDELINES are a big deal
  - No before or after school activities will happen at this time, besides student council and hope squad
  - There will be opportunities for kids to move ahead, but not with the cirriculum because that will be paced. But other opportunities will be available thru IREady and other software programs.
