FOOD SERVICE

TECHNOLOGY

Surveys for Committed Distance Learning students to request the use of a district device are now closed. Committed Distance Learning families that have been granted the use of a district device received an email last week. Families that were added to CDL from the wait list last Monday and requested the use of a device will receive a notification email this week.

Due to the number of requests, we will be distributing the devices from the Olentangy school building your child normally attends. Each building will create a sign up for families to pick up devices before school begins.

WAIT LIST

There have been many inquiries regarding the Committed Distance Learning wait list. Please note, we are not moving students from the current wait list to a Committed Distance Learning classroom at this time. Students on the wait list should plan to attend their Olentangy School in the hybrid attendance model until directed otherwise.
