Teaching as a Profession 3

Strands

- 1. Students will learn about education field professionals, explore teaching career opportunities, develop teaching skills, and make informed decisions about pathways to accomplished teaching
- 2. Students will learn about themselves and their students for the purpose of building relationships and supporting student development
- 3. Students will learn how to build content knowledge to plan relevant learning opportunities that respond to student's needs
- 4. Students will learn effective instructional strategies to engage students and promote learning
- 5. Students will learn to use assessments and interpret data for the purpose of making decisions that will advance teaching and learning
- 6. Students will learn how reflective practice enables them to advance student learning and grow professionally
- 7. Students will develop a unit plan aligned to their content area of interest

Performance Skills

1. Strand 1

- Interview three different education field professionals
 - i. Why did they choose this career?
 - ii. What is the process/education needed to become a professional in this area?
 - iii. What are the benefits of this profession?
 - iv. What are some positive challenges that you have overcome in this profession?
 - v. What are some misconceptions around your role in education?
- Reflect on how you would adapt your philosophies to meet the needs of your stakeholders and current educational issues and influences

2. Strand 2

- Develop a learning opportunity that maximizes student's potential
 - i. Create an introductory activity that engages students to learn more about their peers. (Emphasize personal identities)

Strand 3

- Create a relevant and age-appropriate learning opportunity for students based on the Utah State Core Standards
 - i. State the objective(s) and expected learning outcome(s)
 - ii. Show connection between content and relevance
 - iii. Create a plan that facilitates student growth and development by addressing student's changing needs

4. Strand 4

- Develop a classroom management plan and implement in a mock-classroom setting
 - i. Classroom rules and consequences
 - ii. Guidelines for handling unexpected situations (i.e. inappropriate classroom behavior, health issues, violent behaviors, etc.)
 - iii. Substitute lesson plan/Emergence plan

5. Strand 5

- Develop a 10-question quiz on material covered in Teaching as Profession 3
 - i. Include a variety of question types (Strand 3, Standard 5)
 - ii. Administer to a group of classmates





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- iii. Collect and analyze data and feedback
- iv. Adjust assessment according to data analysis
- v. Reflect and defend adjustments made to assessment
