WHY?

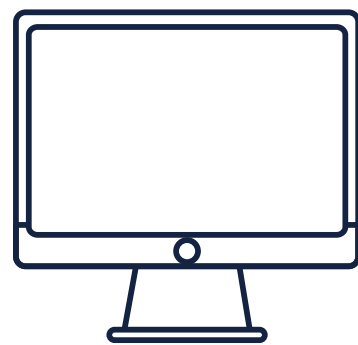
Teachers will be **taking attendance** at the beginning of each Zoom lesson. We want to make sure you don't miss anything important to your learning process.

WHY?

Teachers want to form relationships with their students. Emailing teachers to **stay connected socially and academically** is important as a virtual learner. By Junior High, **students should develop ownership of their learning by asking their teachers questions, rather than relying on their parents to clarify information.**
