Hello Everyone

Because of the safety concerns for the children and parents of this community, I am asking that everyone be more mindful and responsible when driving on campus property. Another safety issue deals with your children exiting on the traffic side of the car instead of the curbside, and drivers getting out and leaving the door open blocking another lane of traffic. It would truly be a tragedy for an injury to a child or a parent by not following simple safety practices. Please keep the following rules in mind at all times

- Do not exceed 15 MPH
- Follow the arrows and traffic flow patterns
- Stay off your *cell phone* while driving
- Do not have your children exit on the driver's side of your vehicle— always at a curbside!
- Do not leave your driver's side door open ever
- Do not stop in the circle to leave off the children it's posted with signs and has yellow traffic cones
- Do not linger when dropping your child off. Please be considerate to the other parents who are waiting for you to move away from the curb so they may drop off their child safely.

The children's safety and welfare should be just as important to you as it is to me. Please help me make this as safe a campus as possible by observing these simple rules.

Also, please be aware that all numbered parking spaces are assigned. Use visitors parking spaces when visiting the campus.
