



ATTENDANCE

Attendance will be based on the following:

- Completion of instructional activities equivalent to 1 per class period per day of digital instruction (includes Wednesdays).
- Attendance will be entered weekly into PowerSchool on Monday mornings
- Attendance is *not* based on performance
- Attendance may not be used to penalize a student for missing a live class session

More details will be available by August 31st.

EXPECTATIONS

- 1. It is not acceptable to be late to your class zoom meeting.
- 2. If you are late due to extenuating circumstances, it is appropriate to apologize for being late. This shows that you have good manners and value and respect your teacher's and your classmates' time.
- 3. It is suggested that you use headphones with a mic for your class meetings. This helps to minimize feedback and background noises which can interfere with the class instruction.

EXPECTATIONS

- 4. Keep your mic on mute until time to speak.
- 5. Dress appropriately for school i.e. t-shirt and appropriate bottoms is strongly recommended.
- 6. School-appropriate language at all times being at home is no excuse for using offensive language, such as curse words, slurs, rude hand gestures or signals, etc. during class instruction, group chats, etc.

EXPECTATIONS

- 7. Your background, profile pictures (ANYTHING visible to others on the zoom class) should be free of posters, images, items, pictures, ANYTHING, that is not school appropriate and that would NOT be allowed in a classroom.
- 8. If your teacher asks you to remove it, do it.
- 9. You may use school-appropriate zoom backgrounds.
- 10. Do follow all of your teacher's instructions.
