Helping to keep each other healthy during COVID is a shared responsibility which we must all diligently follow science-based practices. Individual choices impact us all. As we return to school, each person and family must be willing to demonstrate care and consideration for one another by committing to the following safety precautions developed in partnership with Medical Advisors on Chiaravalle's Health and Safety team.

ACT WITH INVIOLABLE RESPECT TO ONE ANOTHER

We expect each community member will:

- Diligently follow science-based practices to protect self and others
- Assume you, and others carry COVID at all times
- Strictly adhere to daily temperature and symptom monitoring before school and upon arrival as required
- Wear a mask if you are at least 2 years of age unless eating while socially distanced, napping, or in a private office
- Practice hand hygiene and increased sanitation
- Maintain a physical distance of at least 6 feet when possible, inside and outside the school premises
- Stay home when you are sick
- Report close contact exposure, suspected infection of student or household members, and testing to COVID19@chiaravalle.org
- Work with the school and health department to immediately track and notify anyone with whom you have been in close contact
- Be compassionate and reasonable with one another

COOPERATE TO SHELTER OUR COMMUNITY

We encourage each community member to:

- Voluntarily quarantine as much as possible and monitor symptoms 14 days before school begins
- Voluntarily follow regional COVID advice for self-quarantining when traveling from <u>identified</u> <u>hotspots</u>
- Minimize your family social circle as much as possible. Small <u>"quarantine pods"</u> of approximately 5 non-family members is ideal
- Minimize exposure to non-essential in-person extracurriculars

COMMUNICATE TO ENSURE HEALTH AND SAFETY

The school will:

- Notify families when there has been a confirmed case of COVID in the school. If your students' class/pod has been impacted, the school will alert you of close contact and share the health department's guidance including any quarantine requirements in a particular situation.
- Continue to implement the health and safety measures outlined in the Reopening Plan, and introduce any new recommended measures, as they evolve.
