Dear AP Students and Parents:

Welcome to the beginning of the 2020-2021 school year. We understand that your student is enrolled in an AP class and is planning on taking the AP test. Below is pertinent information for this process.

- 1. Each student must create an account on myap.collegeboard.org or use the previous AP number assigned to log-in to his or her account.
- 2. Each student needs to join an AP class section for each AP class. The AP teachers will give the students the access code which allows them to use course materials and resources.
- 3. Each student must confirm the enrollment for an AP test on his or her AP account. The deadline is October 23, 2020.
- 4. Each AP test is \$95 or \$54 for a fee waiver student. Payments are made online on myDSD, by phone or in the main office. The deadline for payment is October 23, 2020.
- 5. Students must notify Mrs. Perry by October 23, 2020 if they DO NOT want to take an AP test.
- 6. Students who are not enrolled in an AP class and desire to take an AP test must contact Mrs. Perry prior to October23, 2019.
- 7. CHANGE OF STATUS If a student drops an AP class or decides to add or drop the AP test after October 23, 2020, he or she MUST complete the change of status form and give it to Mrs. Perry. Failure to do so may result in a mis-order.
- 8. A change of status fee of \$40 will be assessed for tests dropped or added after October 23, 2020. No refunds will be given after February 19, 2021.
- 9. Preregistration Students will complete all preregistration on their AP account.
- 10. The Enrollment and payment deadline for second semester only classes (AP Government) is February 19, 2021. The same process as first semester applies.
- 11. AP tests will be held during the weeks of May 3 to May 7 and May 10 to May 14. See the attached schedule.
- 12. All tests will begin on time. A student arriving late will forfeit the opportunity to take the AP test.
- 13. No phones are allowed in the testing area; however, students can bring a zip lock bag with water and snacks and leave the bag on the bleachers.

- 14. If an unexpected conflict occurs with the testing date, please notify Mrs. Perry ASAP.
- 15. Students who qualify for accommodations must notify Mrs. Perry prior to October 1, 2020.
- 16. Items to bring to the test:
 - A. Government-issued or school-issued photo ID
 - B. Two sharpened No. 2 pencils with erasers
 - C. Two pens (black or blue ink only)
 - D. At least one calculator and spare batteries for biology, calculus, chemistry, physics, or statistics exams.
 - E. Watches are optional (no smart watches or watches with a beep or alarm).

- Schools must begin the morning exam administration between 8 and 9 a.m. local time and the afternoon exam administration between 12 and 1 p.m. local time. The AP Physics C: Electricity and Magnetism Exam must begin between 2 and 3 p.m. local time. Schools in Alaska must begin the morning exam administration between 7 and 8 a.m. local time and the afternoon exam administration between 11 a.m. and 12 p.m. local time. The AP Physics C: Electricity and Magnetism Exam in Alaska must begin between 1 and 2 p.m. local time.
- AP coordinators are responsible for notifying students when and where to report for the exams. Early testing or testing at times other than those published by College Board is not permitted under any circumstances.
- AP coordinators should order late-testing exams for students who would like to take exams that are scheduled for the same time.
- AP Seminar and AP Research students must submit final performance tasks and their presentations must be scored by their AP Seminar or AP Research teachers by 11:59 p.m. ET on April 30, 2021.
- On their AP Digital Portfolio, students participating in AP Computer Science Principles must submit their Create performance task as final by 11:59 p.m. ET on April 30, 2021.
