Dear Friends of Fairfield Public Schools,

I hope this email finds you well amidst your back to school preparations. I am emailing today with a



quick update on our progress.

We are readying school buildings for our students' return on Tuesday, September 8th. Hand sanitizer stations are being installed, signage is being put in place, and hallway markings laid down. Below is an overview of all the physical changes being made to keep our students and staff safe, along with our new cleaning protocols.

As our teachers return, they will be trained on mitigation efforts such as PPE and social distancing. Our Health Department, working with students from Warde and Ludlowe, and our Health Department liaison, Lori Mediate, have prepared two

training videos for students, one for <u>Grades K-5</u> and one for <u>Grades 6-12</u>, that we encourage you to watch with your child(ren) before school starts.

Please remember that for in-person learning to succeed, we need to always act within a shared culture of health and safety. Please be vigilant in monitoring your children's health, and do not send your child to school if s/he is showing symptoms, or with a fever masked by Tylenol or Motrin. This is not the year to send your child to school with a "see how you feel" message. I know this can be an inconvenience, but we need to be mindful of the potential impact on the health of our entire community. We will be providing a health checklist for you to use each morning.





With the student surveys complete, we are rebalancing class lists as necessary, to support students in both hybrid and remote learning plans. We are in the process of establishing the cohorts and will be notifying you next week of their cohort placement.

- Hand sanitizer stations at all entry points and classrooms
- Social distance markers on floors and walls
- Hand washing signage

- Plexiglass partitions in shared offices and greeting areas
- Bathroom stalls blocked off to keep students apart

The district has always used and continues to use Diversey Virex II 256 as the district disinfectant. Diversey Virex II 256 is listed on the CDC website with a kill time of 10 minutes. In addition to Diversey Virex II 256, the district will continue to use Diversey Oxivir Five16 wipes which have a kill time of 5 minutes.
