

## Chromebook Protection Plan

The Chromebook Protection Plan (CPP) is an optional (but strongly recommended) annual plan that provides an inexpensive solution for families to lessen the financial burden if their child's Chromebook is significantly damaged, lost, or stolen.

If parents/guardians opt out of the CPP, they will be fully responsible for any associated cost for damage or theft. The CPP is non-refundable.

\* A police report should be filed within 24 hours. A copy of the police report is required to file a claim for a stolen Chromebook.

\*\* Chargers and Chromebook Bags are not covered under this plan.

### CPP Terms and Conditions

- By purchasing the Renton School District Chromebook Protection Plan (CPP), you attest that:
  - you are a parent/guardian of a Renton School District student
  - you have read and understand the rules & financial responsibilities of the program
  - you agree to all terms and conditions of the program
  - you voluntarily enroll your student for the current school year
- Each student must be enrolled in CPP program separately. Families with 3 or more students in the district only need to pay for two students' enrollments. For all additional students, select the "G2102 MULTIPLE" option. Please note, you will be asked to verify which two students in your household have been paid for.
- Two incidents total, in any combination (damage/stolen), are covered per year.
- If a lost or stolen Chromebook is later recovered in working condition, the fine will be refunded.
- All District owned devices must be returned (including the Chromebook, charger, and bag). If a student leaves the district without returning the Chromebook, they will be fined for the full replacement cost, and standard rules for the restriction of records and transcripts would apply. Law enforcement may be involved for the purpose of recovering district property.
- If technical problems occur with the device, the school will provide a loaner laptop while Renton School District's Technology Services repairs the device. Do not take RSD-owned devices to an outside computer service for repair.
- Intentional damage is **not covered** under this plan.

## How to sign up for Chromebook Protection

<p>Go to the Renton School District website.</p> <p>Select <b>Payments</b> from the menu located under the scrolling images.</p>	
<p>Follow the instructions for logging into the District's Online Payment system.</p> <p>You will be asked: "Who are you shopping for?". Select the button with your student's name on it.</p>	
<p>Choose the option to find <b>Items At Student's School</b>.</p>	
<p>Select <b>Chromebook</b> or <b>Chromebook Protection</b> from the list of categories.</p>	
<p>You will be able to choose between multiple plan options:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>G2102 Chromebook Protection Plan: Standard Plan</b></li> <li>• <b>G2102 Reduced:</b> for students who qualify for reduced lunch.</li> <li>• <b>G2102 Free:</b> for students who qualify for free lunch</li> <li>• <b>G2102 Multiple:</b> for families with 3 or more students</li> <li>• <b>G2102 Decline:</b> for families who do not wish to participate</li> </ul>
