Clean Deep clean and sanitize all classrooms, common areas, and athletic facilities routinely using appropriate products.

Distance

Space student desks in all classrooms as best as possible with seats forward-facing; expand outdoor seating options; ensure social distancing in all common areas.

Face Masks Required

All students, staff, and visitors to campus will be required to wear a face mask at all times, except during physical activities or when consuming meals.



COVID-19 Safety Protocol

- ♦ Teachers will be trained to identify symptoms; students presenting any symptoms of illness will be sent to the School Clinic.
- The school nurse will check the temperature and screen any student or staff member exhibiting symptoms of illness. Any individual with a temperature of 100.4 or higher or presenting symptoms will be isolated until he/she can be sent home.
- ♦ Students returning to school from **any illness** will have a temperature check prior to returning to class.

COVID-19 Safety Protocol

- ♦ Any student or staff member suspected of having COVID-19 or reporting exposure to COVID-19 must self-quarantine at home.
- Sishop Kenny High School will follow the COVID-19 Case Reporting procedures set forth by the Office of the Superintendent for the Diocese of St. Augustine.
- Distance learning options will be offered for any student who must selfquarantine.
- ♦ A student or staff member's return to school is determined by the COVID-19 reporting protocol of the Diocese of St. Augustine.





Transportation

- All BKHS buses will be thoroughly sanitized during the school day in between routes. Drivers will also sanitize all surfaces at the end of the day.
- Students and drivers will be required to wear face masks at all times on the bus as social distancing may not be possible.
- Drivers will scan each student's temperature before boarding the bus in the morning. Any student with a 100.4 or higher temperature may not board.
- All BKHS buses are ventilated with dual air conditioning systems; filters are cleaned routinely.
- Third-party transportation (field trips and athletics) will follow separate procedures to ensure student health and safety.

Activities & Athletics

- Gatherings, events, and activities will be limited to those that can provide appropriate social distancing.
- Traditional meetings and in-person gatherings may include the use of technology to allow attendance from home.
- Athletic teams will follow the protocol set forth by the Florida High School Athletic Association (FHSAA).

Physical Education Classes

- ♦ Students must wear masks at all times in the locker rooms, with the exception of showering.
- Only one class will use the gym court at a time; all other classes will take place outdoors.
- Instructions will stagger return time from class activities to provide adequate social distancing in the locker rooms.
- Instructors will implement additional sports-specific procedures as they pertain to the scheduled activities.



Continuity of Learning and Planning for Academic Growth



Based on the feedback of parents, students, teachers, and counselors, Bishop Kenny High School has developed an **Instructional Continuity Plan** which offers options for **distance learning** should a school closure be necessary.



An Assessment and Student Learning Committee will identify ways to assess student learning and ensure further academic growth.



Plan A – On-Campus Learning

- ♦ We will follow the normal school schedule and routines with distancing and COVID-19 safety procedures in place.
- ♦ Students who must **self-quarantine** due to exposure or suspicion of COVID-19 may continue classes via **distance learning**, including attending class **remotely** via video conferencing.



Plan B Brief School Closure (2-3 days)

Should there be a need for a brief school closure, the following **synchronous learning schedule** will take place:

- ♦ All students will follow the **normal bell schedule** for the day.
- ♦ Students must join class remotely at the scheduled time for virtual instruction. Instruction will be a minimum of 20 minutes, but may extend longer based on the nature of the lesson/discipline.
- Attendance will be recorded by class period.

Plan C Extended School Closure (2-3 weeks)

Should there be a need for an extended school closure, Bishop Kenny will adopt a rotational virtual instruction schedule (synchronous learning):
