Yellow	Specialist lessons Setting Lunch times Play times	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Additional Risk assessment to be carried out for these activities • Where possible keep classes separate from each other within the larger group/classroom • Children should face the front and not each other • Make sure 1m+ (as much space as possible) is between the different class pods • Children to wash hands before joining class, and before returning to own pod • Teachers to keep register of who was present at each session • Ventilation to be increased – open doors and windows, take activity outside if possible • Clean room, especially touch points, between classes/pods - using suitable cleaning spray • Don't share resources between pods, or thoroughly clean • Children to take everything they'll need to lesson – do not share resources or use classroom equipment • Try to keep groups small to enable distancing in classroom • Separate pods during playtimes • Minimise time children are together and maximize ventilation at all times
Orange	Games afternoons Wrap care SuperPirates Homework club Minibus use	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Staff to complete own risk assessment for activity/wrap care/sports lesson to ensure and show they have considered all the risks and how they can reduce them • Homework club – <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ separate into Yr 3&4, Yr5&6. ○ Use different classroom for each year group. Eg – 5M=Yr3, 5G=Yr4, 6I=Yr5, 6S=Yr6. ○ Separate class pods within their classroom. • Children to be pre-booked onto all clubs, including Homework club, to enable staff to ensure adequate space and measures are in place. • Rooms to be cleaned before club starts - by staff using the room/area • Pods to be kept separate as much as possible • Full registers to be kept • SuperPirates <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ to develop own risk assessment – seen and approved by school ○ clean classroom before using ○ SuperPirates to only use own resources and toys, not share schools. • Children reminded to stay with their own pods and to maintain distance • Minimise the time the children are together and maximize ventilation at all times, if possible move activity outside

<p>Red</p>	<p>Sports fixtures Public transport Tours of school Concerts Plays School trips Parents evening</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Additional risk assessment for any Red activity should be made and signed off before it goes ahead and/or is publicised to stakeholders • Sports fixtures <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ other schools must make us aware of their Covid measures ○ only visit/take part, if they are as robust as ours ○ No match tea • Public transport or use of coaches/minibuses by external company <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ school to seek written assurances from any coach company used that they are following Covid measures to ensure risk to our children and staff is at a minimum • Tours of school <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ before visit, make contact to ensure visitors have not been in contact with Covid or are not showing symptoms. ○ Any visitor to use hand gel when arrive at school ○ Face coverings to be worn by visitors in line with current govt. guidelines ○ Tours can go into classrooms but maintain at least 2m distance from staff and children • Concerts <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ to be held outside if possible ○ Consider only small numbers for concerts, year groups, to keep number of parents to a minimum. ○ Parents to be sat in family groups at least 2m apart ○ Ventilation to be kept to a maximum • Plays <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ To be only per year group – keep audience numbers to a minimum ○ Held outside if possible ○ Parents to be sat in family groups 2m apart from others
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
