



**TEACHER  
PROFESSIONAL LEARNING CREDITS**

Professional learning credit encompasses a commitment to continued professional growth and learning which supports student success. The type of professional learning and credits outlined below are the District’s minimum requirements. Employees shall participate in professional learning annually as directed by the principal or department supervisor.

Credits	Professional Learning Type
18	<p><b>Curriculum &amp; Instruction Trade Credit</b> – Credit is earned by attending training that is planned, directed and/or required by the principal, supervisor or District.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <b>EL Teaching Strategies</b> – Credit is earned by attending training in: English Language Proficiency Standards (ELPS), Sheltered Instruction (SI), and Language Proficiency Assessment Committee (LPAC). (3 credits are required for ELAR teachers and Bilingual Certified teachers.)</li> <li>● <b>GT Update Training</b> – Credit is earned by attending 6 hours of update training annually for employees with documentation of 30 hours of previous GT training. All teachers who provide instruction and services that are a part of the district's defined gifted/talented services program for G/T students must receive a minimum of six hours annually of professional learning.</li> </ul>
1	<p><b>Cybersecurity for Educators</b> - Credit is earned by completing the Required Compliance course provided by the district.</p>
6-9	<p><b>Required Compliance (Bloodborne Pathogens; Child Abuse Awareness &amp; Prevention; Freedom from Discrimination, Harassment &amp; Retaliation)</b> – Credit is earned by completing the required eCourse in Eduphoria.</p> <p><b>504 Training</b> - Credit is earned by completing the required eCourse in Eduphoria.</p> <p><b>Working with Students of Trauma</b> - Credit is earned by completing the required eCourse in Eduphoria.</p> <p><b>Allergy &amp; Anaphylaxis (Food Allergy) Training (1 trade credit)</b> - Credit is earned by completing the required course in Eduhero.</p> <p><b>Seizure Training (2 trade credits)</b> - Credit is earned by registering in Eduphoria for the link to complete the online training through The Epilepsy Foundation.</p> <p><b>Multi Hazard Emergency Operations Plan</b> - Credit is earned by attending a face to face training with the designated district or campus staff.</p> <p><b>Cross Guard Training</b> - Credit is earned by completing the required eCourse in Eduphoria. (For staff with crosswalk duty assignments.)</p> <p><b>Parent &amp; Family Engagement Policy (.5 trade credit)</b>- Credit is earned by completing the required eCourse in Eduphoria. (For staff on a Title 1 campus.)</p> <p><b>Stop the Bleed</b> - Credit is earned by completing a face to face class. (For staff specified by the principal or department supervisor.)</p>
1	<p><b>Student Behavior and Management</b> – Annual review by principal or counselor</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Bullying/Cyber Bullying</li> <li>● Dating Violence – Secondary Teachers only</li> </ul>
2	<p><b>NEW TEACHERS: Student Behavior and Management</b> - Suggested resources: Eduhero or counselor</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Bullying/Cyber Bullying</li> <li>● Suicide Prevention</li> </ul>
3	<p><b>T-TESS Review</b> – Credit is earned by completing a face to face training.</p>
6	<p><b>NEW TEACHERS w/ NO PRIOR FULL DAY T-TESS TRAINING</b> – Credit is earned by completing a full day, face to face training.</p>

**NOTE:** It is the sole responsibility of employees to track and maintain their own professional learning (PL) records. In-District professional learning is recorded in Eduphoria by the course instructor. Out of District professional learning must be entered by the attendee and approved by supervisor/principal.
