Device Insurance

Sunset Elementary is providing an Optional Laptop/iPad protection plan for students and parents. The Discretionary Protection Plan supports the Computer Use Agreement and enrollment in the plan is optional with the understanding that if students/parents do not enroll in the protection plan, they will carry full liability for the laptop/iPad in the same way they do for other damaged or lost school property, such as textbooks.
