The Homeless Outreach Support Team (HOST) is an outreach-based program providing services in the field to engage chronically homeless individuals with mental illness into permanent supportive housing. HOST staff works with qualified individuals to complete the necessary applications and assessments in the field and, upon receipt of housing voucher, assist the individual to locate and move into housing. HOST services continue with recovery-based wraparound case management services to the individual to assist them in their recovery and wellness and to reintegrate them into the community with the ultimate goal independence and self-sufficiency.
