While many things have changed in the last 6 months, the BFS PTO remains committed to bringing our children many of the same activities we have come to cherish over the years. Our goal as PTO board members is to support children and collaborate with teachers, staff, and families to make sure each student has the best possible experience while learning and growing at Booth Free School. Please join us when we meet on <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>September 9th and on the 3rd Wednesday of every month thereafter at 6:30 pm</u>. We encourage you to get involved wherever you can -- our BFS traditions are renewed each year with your participation!

We would like to take a moment to introduce some changes to PTO programs and remind you of the many ways the PTO works in partnership with the BFS community.
