PowerSchool opened this morning for you and your child to view teacher assignments and schedules. To create student schedules for Committed Distance Learning classes, our team is working with many priorities and variables. Whenever possible, we placed students with peers from their building, and in classes with teachers from their same physical school. We were also diligent with the placement of students with special services, specifically special education, gifted services, and English Language Learners., and in class sizes that enable students to receive the individual attention they are accustomed to in an Olentangy classroom.

Middle school and high school students will have teachers from other Olentangy buildings depending on the complexity of their individual schedule. All of our Committed Distance Learning teachers are equally enthusiastic to work with students in their digital classrooms. We are removing the physical school/classroom barrier, with teachings connecting with students in a new way to build community and learn this semester.

Additional components of some schedules may not yet be finalized, and we appreciate your patience as we finish that work this week. Elementary specials assignments will be posted later this week. Middle school electives will be selected by students and families in September once core academic courses are underway. Furthermore, if your child receives special education services and they don't have a schedule loaded immediately, please be patient. We are working with our specialized staff to balance caseloads and assign appropriate teachers.

Finally, schedule changes for Middle school and High school students will be attended to by your assigned counselor at your home building. Please wait until the first week of classes to submit any requests if possible.
