Stevenson High School Fall Sports Spectator Policy

High School Sports are an important time for athletes and families to enjoy community and competition, within the contest of education-based athletics. We appreciate the support of our Patriot Families and enjoy our partnership.

To ensure that we provide a safe and healthy environment for all participants, including athletes, coaches, officials, workers, and spectators, we have put these spectator measures in place for our fall home competitions.

- 1. Assume that spectators are not permitted at away competitions, unless otherwise communicated by the Stevenson Athletic Office or Staff.
- 2. No spectators will be permitted at our indoor athletic events due to ISBE limits on individuals at indoor gatherings. We hope to provide live-stream broadcasts of these events as soon as possible.
- 3. Spectators will be permitted at outdoor events under the following provisions:
 - a) Do not attend the competition if you are experiencing any <u>Covid-19-related</u> <u>symptoms</u>
 - b) Only members of the competitor's immediate household can attend
 - c) Spectators must remain in designated areas**
 - d) Spectators must adhere to all social distance guidelines
 - e) Spectators must wear masks/face coverings at all times
 - f) Spectators must indicate they plan to attend by signing in <u>SIGN IN HERE</u> or use the QR code



** Cross Country – Spectators are not allowed at the start or finish area on the north end of VHAC.. Spectators are required to park in the south lot at Vernon Hills Athletic Complex - VHAC (308 Patriot Way) and cannot be on the cross country course at any time. (If you place a lawn chair near the brick building, you will see your child at least three times during the race (make signs, bring noisemakers, have fun @ - but stay 6 feet apart).

** Golf – Spectators are not allowed within 75 feet of any competitor on the course. Do not speak with your child during the competition at any time. Adhere to proper golf spectator etiquette. Maintain social distance guidelines before and after competition.

** Tennis – There will be a temporary fence constructed at the facility. Spectators are not allowed within the fenced area. You may observe the competition from outside the fenced area. Adhere to proper tennis spectator etiquette. Maintain social distance guidelines before and after competition.
