The Bottom Line About Distancing and Quarantine Criteria

When a person tests positive for the coronavirus, we will support the Arkansas Department of Health (ADH) in their contact tracing efforts, by identifying probable close contacts. While there are some factors that will be considered in each case that might extend the group that is required to quarantine, the answer to the following question is the most important.

Have you been within 6 feet for 15 cumulative minutes or longer within a 24 hour period to a person who has tested positive for COVID-19, during the infectious period?

If the answer is YES, face coverings or not, you will be required to quarantine.

Goal#1: Minimize the spread of COVID-19

Strategies

- 6 foot distancing
- Minimizing interactions
 - Cohorts
 - Movement patterns through school spaces
- Face coverings
- Air filtration and ventilation
- Use of outdoor spaces
- Hand hygiene
- Cleaning and sanitizing surfaces

Goal#2: Minimize the number of people required to quarantine

Strategies

- 6 foot distancing
- Minimizing interactions
 - Cohorts
 - Movement patterns through school spaces
- Clear documentation
 - Seating Charts
 - Schedules
