Why Didn't I Get an Agreement?

Agreement will be sent to parent's email address that is on file with the school. Check OnCourse to see which email you have provided.

You may need to turn in your transfer card

Check your spam folder

Why Was My Agreement Declined?

Your agreement may have been declined for missing or incorrect information

If you have children in both schools, make sure you signed the agreement with the correct child's name. Separate agreements are sent for high school & middle school students.

What Do I Do When I Get To School?

You will log into:

- Periods 1-8 on Mondays (asynchronous, no live classes)
- Tuesdays/Thursdays: only the classes that are held Periods 1-4
- Wednesdays/Fridays: only the classes held Periods 5-8

All Tuesday-Friday classes will meet in the mornings starting at 8am. These classes are live video lessons and students must attend to be marked present for class.

Student Responsibilities

- Attend your live lessons and any small group sessions you are assigned to by your teacher. You will be marked present only if you attend your live lessons – or if you have made a prior arrangement with your dean or teacher to watch a makeup lesson.
- If you can't attend the live lesson, make sure to review the recorded lesson before the end of the day so you can stay on track.
- Text your dean if you are having any difficulties with your computer or internet so they can assist you in a timely manner.
- Respond promptly to any emails or texts from your teachers, deans and administration. We are here to help, but we can't help if you don't respond!
- Remember that your teachers are not required to respond to emails, calls or texts after hours. If you have an extenuating circumstance and need to speak to your teacher outside of normal school hours, please let them know in advance whenever possible.
- Make sure to reach out to guidance counselors if you are feeling overwhelmed, stressed, have a personal or academic issue, or need working papers. All guidance services will continue during online learning.
- Check your grades regularly in OnCourse to make sure you are staying on top of your studies
