



## Key Elements of Elementary School Remote Learning

- Synchronous Learning: (Students learning together through online classes and video conferencing).
- Small group instruction for students in need of extra support.
- Teacher office hours through phone calls and emails.
- Teacher-facilitated learning through assignments.
- Culturally responsive support for social emotional learning and mental health.
- Grading based on: SP - Strongly in Place; MP - Making Progress; ND - Needs Development.
- Attendance requirements based on teacher contact with students.
- Specially designed instruction based on IEP goals for Special Education students.



## What will a typical day look like for my elementary school-age child?

Individual schools will be setting daily schedules for their students, but the school day will follow a standard 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday-Friday schedule. Schedules will include the following opportunities:

- Student meetings with teachers and instructional assistants online with their classmates and in smaller groups.
- Time for students to work on assignments online and offline.
- Time for teachers to reach out to students/families to provide feedback and online support.
- Interactions with specialists in areas such as CDS, music and physical education.
- Breaks for lunchtime, office hours and wellness activities.
