Meal Distribution During Remote Instruction

During the first 9 weeks of the school year, Mt. Lebanon School District will be operating via remote instruction of our students. The Food Service Department will be distributing meals daily outside of each elementary school during remote instruction! Meals will be available from 10:45 until 1:15 every day to accommodate all students during their lunch periods. A menu can be found on our district website and the menu will consist of: a daily hot entrée, deli sandwich, bagel bag or garden salad. Breakfast will also be available if you desire a breakfast for the next day! Breakfasts will consist of a milk, juice cup and cereal w/ a muffin or pop tarts! Prices for the meals are as follows:

Lunch	Breakfast
Paid - \$2.50	Paid - \$1.60
Reduced - \$0.40	Reduced - \$0.30

We will be distributing a survey via email each week. It is important, for production purposes, that this survey is completed ONCE for EACH student in your family that intends to purchase meals during the week. We ask that this survey is completed by Sunday evening so we can compile numbers on Monday morning.

FAQs

1) If I complete the survey, will my student(s) be charged for a meal?

No, you will not be charged based on your participation in the survey. The survey results will allow us to send proper amounts of each food item to each school to ensure every student gets what they want!

2) Are all meals free as they were in the Spring/Summer?

No, all meals are not free anymore. Meals will be charged based on the student's meal benefit status. They will be charged full price, a reduced price or free price accordingly. We will use paper rosters at each school to track meals each day and will charge each student account accordingly at the end of each day. Deposits can still be made on lunch accounts by sending checks/cash with the student's name and student PIN to:

3) **Do I have to purchase lunch and breakfast at the same time?**

No, you do not. You can purchase only a lunch, or only a breakfast!

4) **How will I know what is on the menu each day?**

5) **How do I know what elementary school to pick up meals at each day?**

Feel free to pick your meals up at any location! In the survey you will indicate which elementary you intend to pick your meals up at.

6) **Will meals be distributed at the middle schools or high school?**

We are sorry; meals will not be distributed at either middle school or the high school. Meals will only be distributed at the elementary schools.

7) **My student is a part of the Extended Day program, at a school they don't normally attend, can they still purchase meals?**

Yes! When completing our survey, please indicate that the meals will be "picked up" at the school your student is attending Extended Day at. Students are free to pick up meals at any school, regardless of the school they are currently attending. We simply ask that you accurately indicate on the survey where the meals will be picked up at. Any student enrolled in Mt. Lebanon School District is able to utilize our meal distribution program!

8) **Does my student have to be present when I am picking up meals?**

No, your student does not have to be present. We will ask the names of any student you are picking up meals for and charge their student accounts accordingly.

9) **I have multiple students. Can one of my students pick up meals for the other students in our household?**

Yes, we will handle this as we do a parent picking up multiple meals without a student present. We will ask the names of all students who are having meals picked up for them and will charge their student accounts accordingly.

10) **Where should I pick up meals at each location?**

Foster – Meals available outside of door A9 from 10:45-1:15. This door enters into the gym and is closest to the tennis courts. If you're driving, please park in front of the school and walk up to the door.

Markham – Meals available outside of door A1 from 10:45-1:15. This is the main entrance to the school.

Hoover – Meals available on the governor's driveway from 10:45-1:15. Feel free to walk or drive up the driveway to pick up meals.

Jefferson – Meals available outside of door A1 from 10:45-1:15. This is the main entrance to the school. Feel free to walk or drive up the driveway to pick up meals.

Howe – Meals available outside of door D14 from 10:45-1:15. This door is in the primary courtyard of the school. If you walk back the path between the school and the tennis courts, it will open up to a small courtyard where we will be distributing meals. If you're driving, please park in front of the school and walk to the doors for your meals.

Lincoln – Meals available outside of door D16 from 10:45-1:15. This is the door leading into the right side of the school from the small parking lot. Please DO NOT pull into the parking lot. You can park in front of the school and walk to the door D16 to pick up your meals.

Washington – Meals will be available at the playground entrance at Lawncroft Avenue from 10:45-1:15. This entrance is at the rear of the school at the corner of Lawncroft Avenue and Roselawn Avenue.
