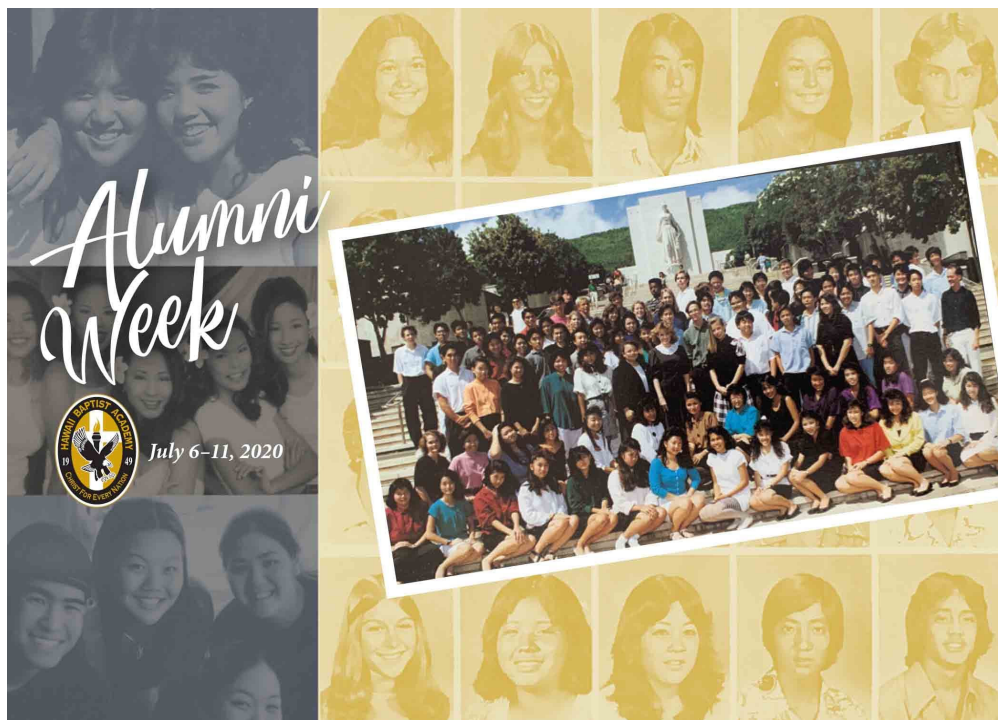
### Former Staff
