Perkiomen School Daily Health Screening for 2020-2021 Academic Year

*All students, faculty, staff, vendors, and visitors to campus are required to participate in a **health screening** before arriving to Perkiomen School's campus. Every person on campus is also required to **wear a mask**, as per the Pennsylvania Universal Face Coverings Order, and practice **social distancing**, keeping at least six feet apart.*

Daily health screenings are an important part of our Health and Safety plan and have been shown to be an effective method to limit the spread of infectious disease. Prior to arrival on campus or leaving your residence each day, please complete the questionnaire below. Students will complete the questionnaire via the Magnus Health App.

If you answer yes to any of the five questions below, please stay home.

- Non-teaching faculty and staff: Notify your supervisor and if necessary, follow up with your primary care physician.
- Teaching and residential faculty: Notify Kevin Manferdini, Jonathan Moser, and your department head as soon as possible of your absence.
- Vendors and Visitors: Please reschedule your appointment.

IF YOU ANSWER, YES, TO ANY OF THE FOLLOWING QUESTIONS, PLEASE STAY HOME:

- Do you have a temperature of 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or above?
- Do you have an uncontrolled cough that causes difficulty breathing, a change in cough baseline (for those with chronic allergic/asthmatic cough), shortness of breath or difficulty breathing?
- Do you have a new onset of loss of taste or smell?
- In the last 14 days, did you care for or have close contact with someone diagnosed with COVID-19 within 6 feet for 15 minutes or more?
- Do you have TWO OR MORE of the below symptoms?
 - Muscle aches or body aches or chills
 - Sore throat, congestion, or runny nose
 - Diarrhea, nausea, or vomiting
 - New onset of a headache
 - Fatigue
