

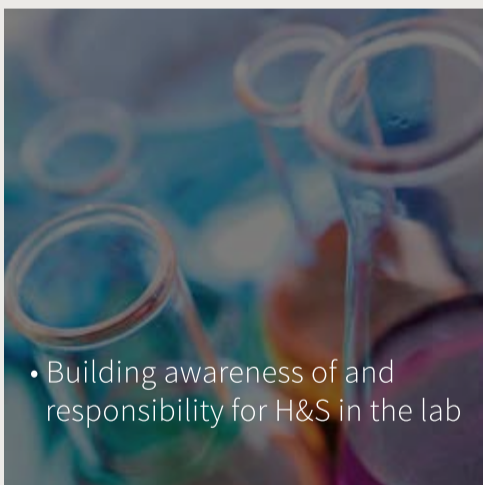


**Health and Safety for Science Technicians and Safety with Chemicals**  
*CLEAPSS is regularly consulted by government; it's advice and documentation is recognised by the Health and Safety Executive and the Department for Education in the UK.*

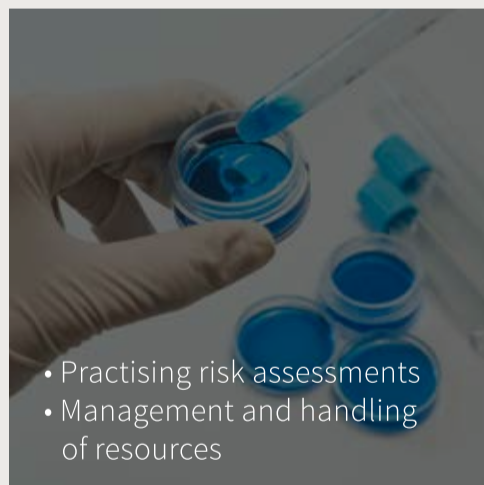
**Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> - Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> March 2019**

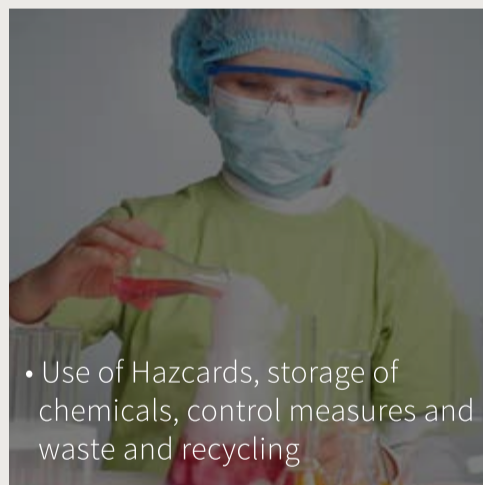
**The CLEAPSS-led course will look at best practice in H&S, including:**



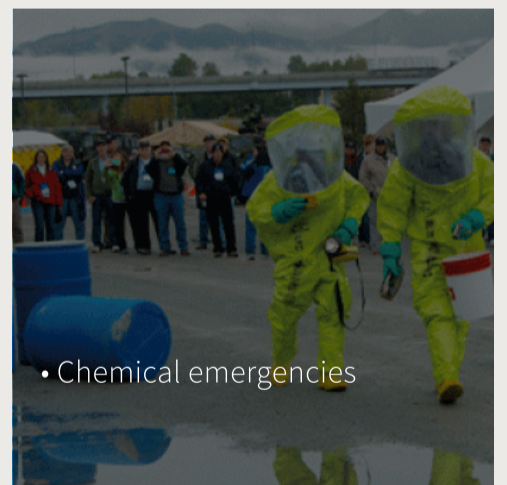
- Building awareness of and responsibility for H&S in the lab
