Hosts

This Maths JAWs will be hosted at the British Vietnamese International School in Hanoi. The school is conveniently located 20 minutes away from the centre of Hanoi, and 1 hour from Hanoi Noi Bai International Airport.

Programme

There is an expectation that all attendees actively participate throughout the two days, and lead at least 1 x 50-minute workshop. Once registration is closed, all participants will be contacted and asked to provide information about their session that they are leading. Workshops will have the opportunity to be tailored towards secondary teachers, primary teachers or teachers from both sections. A website will be created to share resources and ideas from across the two days. In addition to sharing ideas, an aim of this JAWs is also to help create a supportive network for after the event.

Possible themes across the two days may include:

- Using the Frayer Model in the Mathematics Classroom.
- How to develop mathematics specific vocabulary.
- Functional projects which promote mathematical literacy.
- Schemes of Work.
- Assessing progress.
- Language policy in the classroom.
- Using TA/EAL support effectively in Mathematics lessons.
- How to develop students to apply their vocabulary to create a mathematical argument.
- Research findings from studies based in Mathematics classrooms in international schools.
- Challenges and opportunities of teaching in bilingual mathematics classrooms.
