HEALTH & SAFETY MEASURES



Physical Distancing

Students will sit in alternate desks/table areas to allow distancing.



Students

Teachers will assign seats and place desks and tables in rows. Shared learning tools and learning materials will be limited.



Specials/Electives

Instruction for some specials/electives may take place inside the classroom.



Face Coverings

The Governor's mandate requires face coverings for all students, staff and other persons present in any kindergarten through grade 12 school, district building or office.



Hand Sanitizing

Hand sanitizing dispensers will be at entryways, and also near cafeterias and restroom facilities.



Distance Learning

For students who opt in and for students who are quarantined, we will offer distance learning.



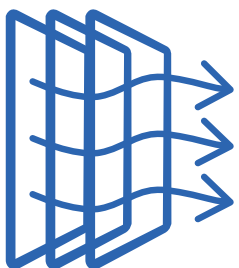
Signage

Hand Washing

Teachers will encourage students to frequently wash their hands during the school day.



Clean Air

District ventilation standards push 20% fresh air into a classroom at all times, exchanging all air at a minimum seven times per hour.
