

Multiple Entry Points

Students will be entering through multiple entrances to reduce bottlenecks and maintain physical distancing.

Controlled Traffic Patterns

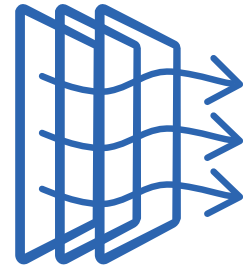
School leaders and teachers will work together to schedule the movement of classes in the building.

Increased Disinfection

Door handles, handrails and restrooms will be sanitized with hospital-grade disinfectant throughout the school day.

Isolation Rooms

A dedicated space will be available to individuals displaying symptoms to be temporarily isolated until they go home.



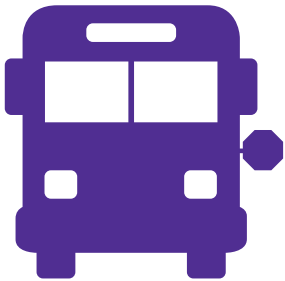
Clean Air

District ventilation standards push 20% fresh air into a classroom at all times, exchanging all air at a minimum seven times per hour.



Hand Sanitizing

Hand sanitizing dispensers will be at entryways, and also near cafeterias and restroom facilities.

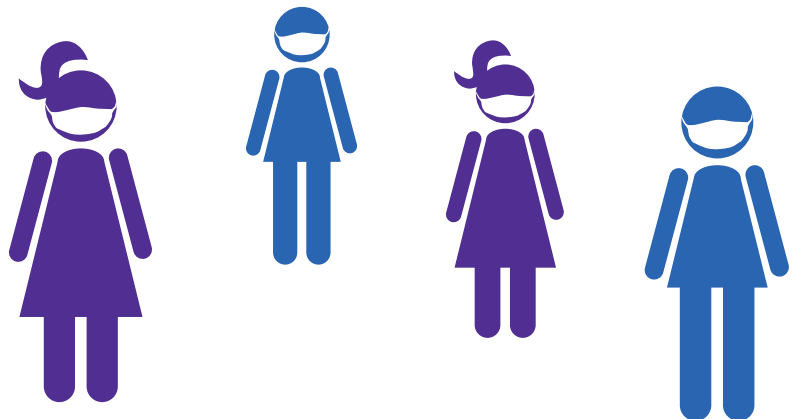


Bus

Seats will be assigned and the loading and unloading of students will be coordinated to maintain physical distancing.

Reduce Congregation

We will reduce the number of people gathering in areas such as the cafeteria, main office and locker rooms. There will be no large assemblies. Visitors to the school will be limited. Face coverings are required for all students, staff and other persons.



Food Service

Meals will be served in the cafeteria by staff. Students will not touch common utensils or PIN pad and will eat at a social distance.



Playgrounds

Outdoor areas such as playgrounds will be open. Students will be reminded to stay 6 feet apart.

Outdoor Spaces

Fields, courts and open areas will be used as additional learning spaces when appropriate.
