Dear Parent / Guardian:

The Haldane Central School District will continue to use the Prepaid Lunch Program. Each **Elementary** student has already been assigned a Personal Identification Number (PIN) that is entered into a keypad each time he/she purchases a meal. **Middle School** and **High School** students will use their ID card, which is scanned into the system.

Due to the COVID-19 crisis, students can no longer purchase breakfast/lunch with cash. You have two options to fund your child's account.

Option 1 - Checks can be made payable to: "Haldane Cafeteria Fund" and remitted to your child's teacher (for Elementary, Middle School and High School) One check may be remitted per family. Please record the child's name and amount on the memo line of the check.

Option 2 - You can through Heartland Payment Systems, make deposits into your student's school meal accounts. A \$2.49 per transaction convenience fee will apply. We are encouraging ALL parents to set up accounts. The information you have access to once you have set up an account is extremely helpful, such as low balance email reminders as well as the ability to view account balances and purchases online 24 hours per day, 7 days a week.

To get started, please visit the webpage by going to the District page (haldaneschool.org) click on Department choose Cafeteria and click on My School Bucks to register. You may also go to mySchoolBucks.com and register using the "Start Here" link on the right side of the page. A confirmation email will be sent to the address you provide. Simply follow the link included in that email and your registration will be complete. Once you log in, you can add as many students as you'd like by entering each student's school, their name and date of birth.

The full meal prices are as follows:

Elementary (K-5) – \$3.00

MS/HS (6-12) - \$3.20

Breakfast - \$1.70
